## RELATIONAL RESILIENCE: CENTERING SAFETY IN THE SPACE BETWEEN YOU AND ME

Children are people, and people need affection, attention, connection, and direction! This two-hour session will unpack those four domains as we consider what we know from a trauma-responsive and resilience-building perspective. No matter where kids or families are coming from, relationships with early childhood caregivers, educators, and other caring adults present opportunities to build on the resilience one has and/or offer healing spaces that mitigate the effects of early childhood trauma within the context of safe, predictable relationships.
